

Arnold-Ronish Tattoo Removal Scale

This scale is meant to help with the determination of the success of tattoo removal by Tattoo Vanish on any particular tattoo. All of the parameters must be evaluated and multiplied by the size of the area to be removed. You will then be able to determine a close estimate of the number of treatments and the cost of each treatment.

First evaluate:

- 1. Skin Type**
- 2. Location on body**
- 3. Color of ink**
- 4. Amount of ink**

- 1) Skin type pertains to the color of the skin. The lighter, the easier the removal will be. The darker the skin the harder it might be with a potential for hyper pigmentation (darkening) or hypo pigmentation (lighting) or more scarring with darker skin types. Allow at least 3-5 treatments**
- 2) Location on the body, some areas of the body are harder to remove and will require additional treatments more than other locations on the body. Examples are the hands, fingers, elbows, feet or ankle. Also any area that is soft like the abdomen where it is difficult to get a good stretch on the skin will be a little more difficult. Allow 4-6 treatments**
- 3) Color of ink, unlike the Laser, Tattoo Vanish does not care what color the ink is. Tattoo Vanish will remove all of the colors. On occasions some colors might be more stubborn but that is probably on rare instances. No additional treatments will be needed due to color with Tattoo Vanish**
- 4) Amount of ink, always ask if they had a cover up over the original tattoo or how many times has the tattoo had ink put into it. The more ink the more treatments to get it all out. It comes out layer by layer. Allow 3-4 additional treatments more than you would (**

the needler

in addition) to the number of treatments you would normally need, (example , maybe it is a 1"x1" tattoo but is a cover up. Normally it might take 3 treatments to remove , but since it is a cover up there is twice the ink in the skin add an additional 3-4 treatments to that number for a total of 6-7 treatments)

Always remember to take in to consideration that skin has to be evaluated as to how it heals, certain nationalities tend to scar more easily, (Asians, African Americans, Hispanics) Always ask the client if they tend to scar or show you an old scar to evaluate potential out come. Remember that Tattoo Vanish is no harder on the skin than getting the tattoo in the first place. With tattoo Vanish we only go into the very top of the 2nd layer of the skin the Dermis. We do not go through a full thickness of skin as in major surgery, thus less risk of scarring.

Prices per size: (all prices are per treatments)

- 1. 1"x1" \$150.00**
- 2. 2"x2" \$290.00**
- 3. 3"x3" \$430.00**
- 4. 4"x4" \$600.00**

Take the size of the tattoo to be removed times the number of treatments you determine to be needed and you will find the total cost. (It is better to estimate a little lower so you get the client in to get started, than to evaluate it very high and lose the client. You can also be very flexible with what their budget is and if they can only afford a \$150 treatment that is what you do at a time.

If you evaluate that they will need 3 treatments of #4 size that would be a total of \$1,800.00

Packages are available:

If the client wants to save a little money they can pay for the full package at a discounted price. Example gives a discount of 10% off of the \$1,800 package and they save \$180.00 to pay all up front. Making the package only \$1620.00. We have a NO REFUND policy.
